

Accommodation

Club de Español offers a wide variety of accommodation options to satisfy any student's needs. All accommodations are carefully chosen: they are clean, safe, and accessible to public transportation. Club de Español is committed to ensuring you enjoy your stay in Madrid!

Option 1 - Home Stay:

Living with a Spanish family is one of the best ways to achieve total immersion in Spanish language and culture (not to mention food) and practice what you learn in class. Spanish families are welcoming and informal, and our host families are carefully chosen to ensure a great experience in an authentic Spanish environment. All families are within Madrid proper, ensuring easy transportation to and from the school. In some cases there may be 2 or 3 students in a particular family. Students can choose between a single or double bedroom, as well as among a number of meal plans. In some cases the student may have an ensuite bathroom, for which there will be no extra charge. All prices except those for self-catering accommodation include laundry service by the host family.

Option 2 – Residence Hall:

Living in a residence hall is the perfect choice for the student wanting to meet other students with whom to share the experience of living in Madrid. Residence halls are located in the O'Donnell and Santiago Bernabeu areas of Madrid, both safe, easily accessible by public transportation, and close to cultural and gastronomic attractions. Accommodation in a residence hall includes cleaning and laundry services, and the use of a common dining space and television lounge. Students can choose between a single or double bedroom, as well as among a number of meal plans. Meals are served cafeteria-style, affording students the option to eat and mingle with their peers. Space limited.

Option 3 – Flatshare:

Flatshare affords the independent student a chance to live with other international students while studying in Madrid. All flats have been carefully screened, and all are within Madrid proper and easily accessible by public transportation. Flats may have anywhere from three to seven bedrooms, accommodating six to ten people. Flats are totally furnished and have their own sheets and towels. All flats include a common kitchen, living room, and one or more bathrooms, depending on size. In some cases, students may have a private bathroom, for which there will be no extra charge. Common spaces will be cleaned once a week. Students can choose between a single or double bedroom. All accommodation is self-catering.

Option 4 – Bedsit:

Bedsits offer the international student the flexible accommodation option of living in a building divided up into small apartments. Bedsits are available in the Banco de España area of Madrid. Each apartment has a television and air conditioning. Groups of three or four apartments share a common bathroom and kitchenette. Students can choose between a single or double bedroom. All accommodation is self-catering, and students will be charged separately for electricity.

Prices on request. As a guideline, single rooms cost approximately 170€ per week, and double rooms cost approximately 140€ per week.

Airport Pickup:

Airport pickup is available with all accommodations. The standard price of pickup is 40€. Pickup for two students booking together is only 60€.

Deposit:

A refundable deposit is required for all accommodation. A deposit of 200€ is required for stays of four weeks or more; 100€ for a stay of three weeks; and 60€ for a stay of one or two weeks.
